Construction Contract 11-186-3F Addison Creek Reservoir, Bellwood, IL, is being financed by the Clean Water State Revolving Fund (SRF). The SRF program is administered by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency and receives a portion of its money to fund these types of projects from the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency. SRF programs operate in each state to provide communities the resources necessary to build, maintain, and improve the infrastructure that protects one of our most valuable resources: water.

Project Description: This project will create an approximately 600 acre-foot flood control reservoir in Bellwood just north of Washington Boulevard and east of Addison Creek. This project includes reservoir excavation and installation of necessary appurtenances for operation of the facility, such as control structure, inlet structure, spillway, piping, and a pumping station.

Project Justification: This project along with the Addison Creek Channel Improvements project will help alleviate public health and safety concerns by reducing overbank flooding to approximately 2,200 structures along Addison Creek from Northlake to Broadview. Approximately 1,700 of 2,200 benefiting structures will be removed from the floodplain. In addition to providing flood control benefits, this reservoir will serve as compensatory storage for the channel improvement project.
