Farhan Qureshi Continued to September 13, 2017 for status.



Ms. Sanders reported that since the last meeting of the Board, there have been twenty-eight (28) requests for leaves of absence, which the Board ratified.


Ms. Sanders reported that since the last meeting of the Board, there have been four (4) expired eligible lists.
