## MWRD Offers Watershed Management Ordinance Compliance Trainings

To assist Cook County communities with complying with the Watershed Management Ordinance (WMO) which takes effect May 1, staff from the Metropolitan Water Reclamation District of Greater Chicago (MWRD) will offer technical training for public works directors and engineers, developers and the engineering consultant design community.
