MWRD to hold Study Session to discuss effects of COVID-19 on operations on June 29, 2020 at 1 p.m.

At the direction of Metropolitan Water Reclamation District of Greater Chicago (MWRD) Commissioner Mariyana T. Spyropoulos, Chairman of the Committee on Pension, Human Resources & Civil Service, the MWRD will hold a Study Session by video conference on June 29, 2020 at 1 p.m. to examine the impact of the COVID-19 pandemic on MWRD operations.
