**Unacceptable Items:**

- ⊘ Needles, syringes, lancets, injection pens
- ⊘ Medical waste
- ⊘ Liquids
- ⊘ Chemo/cytotoxic drugs
- ⊘ Contaminated materials, such as gloves, tubing or IV bags
- ⊘ Batteries, aerosol spray cans
- ⊘ Trash or other hazardous material
- ⊘ Illicit drugs (Schedule I controlled substances) such as marijuana, cocaine, heroin & methamphetamine
