## Study Session to discuss MWRD Ethics Ordinance set for Mon., Oct 19 at 10 a.m.

The Metropolitan Water Reclamation District of Greater Chicago (MWRD) Board of Commissioners will hold a Study Session by video conference to discuss the MWRD's Ethics Ordinance at 10 a.m. on Monday, October 19, 2020.
